

STATE AUTHORIZATION RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT (SARA)

COMPLAINT PROCEDURES - DGCE ONLINE COURSES

IMPORTANT: Massachusetts is part of the National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (NC-SARA)

Students enrolled in online courses who are residents of states other than Massachusetts, and when such state is a SARA participating state, may submit complaints to the Interim Dean Nora Padykula by completing the Online Student Complaint Form.

Efforts will be made to determine the appropriate course of action, and the student will be notified within 10 days following the receipt of a complaint.

If the attempt to resolve the complaint via internal institutional processes fails, students enrolled in online courses who are residents of states other than Massachusetts, and when such state is a SARA participating state, may appeal the College's decision to the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education which makes complaint forms available on its website.
